award rules

The local radio club of Eckernförde, DOK MØ1, issues this award on occasion of the 700th anniversary of the city of Eckernförde in three classes for

QSOs from 01. 01. 2003 on.

For an award-application you have to prove the following **confirmed** points:

Class 1 - 100 points / Class 2 - 70 points / Class 3 - 40 points

Points: Each QSO with stations from local radio club of Eckernförde, DOK MØ1, including the club stations DLØEO, DLØJN and DLØHMK counts 10 points. A contact with one of the club stations is not obligatory. Any other QSOs with stations of District M of German Amateur-Radio-Club (DARC), that means stations with M-DOK, stations with the DOKs Z10, Z69, Z71 and Z72 as well as QSOs with special DOKs DVM, YLM, SH and SHF each count 2 points. QSOs have to be made under the same callsign, however additions like /p or /m are allowed.

Application: Within an application each callsign may appear only once per band and mode. All bands and modes, except packet-radio, are allowed.
