

## Award Rules “Burgendiplom Westfalen-Nord” (Castle-Award Westfalen-Nord)

The German Amateur-Radio-Club, local group Herten (DOK N 20), is issuing this award, which is eligible for hams and short wave listeners.

All contacts made after the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010 with portable (/p)-stations, which are or were located within a radius of max. 1000 meter of a castle in Westfalen-Nord-District, are valid.

Every castle is tagged with a number “Westfalen-Nord-Burgen-Nummer” (WNB) which means Westfalen-Nord-Castle-Number. The WNB-number must be printed, stamped or written in clear script on the qsl-card by the operators of the /p-stations.

You can get a list with the WNB-numbers from the award manager (with SASE) or from the internet.

For the award application every castle-number is valid only once, regardless of the band.

For the award application are needed:

7 different WNB-numbers for	DL-Stations
5 different WNB-numbers for other	EU-Stations
3 different WNB-numbers for	DX-Stations

You can apply for the award in every mode (except packet radio and Echo-Link), also mixed.

With the right proof you can get the award also for a single mode or a single band.

You can send the award application with a list of the qsl-cards (being confirmed by a fellow ham's signature) (GCR-List) and a fee of 5 Euro (for DL-Stations) or 10 Euro / 13 US-Dollar (for EU- and DX-Stations) to the following address:
