Worldwide Radio Communication

The Deutsche Amateur-Radio-Club e. V. is the independent representative of the federally licensed German Amateur Radio operators. These licenses are issued on a Germany statutory basis, as well as through international treaties and recommendations, and are authorized for worldwide radio communication.

More than 67,500 Persons in Germany Enjoy the Fascination of Amateur Radio

The DARC e. V. has more than 35,600 members in Germany and is organized into 24 regional districts with more than 1,000 local clubs. The administration of the DARC e.V. takes place centralized in the headquarters office in the German Amateur Radio Center in Baunatal near Kassel.

Services of the Headquarters Office

Supporting the members and the local clubs is the first priority on the list of duties of the office staff. Other main duties of the office include the finance and accounting for the DARC e.V., the coordination of information, the worldwide distribution of radio confirmation cards (QSL cards) and the production of the monthly club magazine CQ DL. About 4.5 million QSL cards are sorted and distributed yearly in Baunatal.
