4N7Z: no QSOs on 15 and 10... 4X1VF: again bad conditions on 21/28 - hope better next year... 5A1A: participate and we are in joy... 5B4/SM0TGC: nice to work from a really good QTH... 5B4XF: five LUs called me in a row on 80 while desperately looking for Europe... AA8U: Part time entry this year was great fun... CT1BWW: see you next year with maybe many QSOs on 28 MHz... CT4MS: nothing on 10, but QRM on 80 and 40... DJ4PI: WAE is a true challenge - I am in the contest since '58... DJ9MT: much fun - despite low sunspots... DK1RU: worst conditions ever... DK4TB: even on 80 m a short dipole was enough... DK5RA: after 2,5 hours the amplifier gave up... DL2HQ: a hard job with 100 watts... DL9OT: despite indoor antenna: I was in the contest... DL9SD: worked 5A1 and 3V8, wow... EA2CR: QRP 5 watts to LW... EA3ALV: one of the hardest contests... EA9TQ: contesting with braille (I am nearly blind) is very difficult... G6QJ: hard work, 21 MHz signals rare... IT9AJP: waiting for good propagation... JA1AAT: condx EU-JA not good... K1JKS: dismal condx with 15 m finally opening up late Sunday. Lots of weak sigs to pull out of the noise. A big signal on 20m would be S3... LY1DT: my homebrew transceiver broke down... LY5A: lost few multipliers on 10m because linear amp died... LY5W: not so successfully -

two broken transceivers RA3AD and TS-820... LYR-196: wonderful for SWLs and a hard job for station operators... LZ9A: still favourite contest of us all... N4UH: 48 hours too long for this 77 year old ham, but had fun... OK1DRQ: bad condx for low power... OZ5EV: heard South-EU working DX on 10 and 15 which I could not even hear... PI4TUE: ...even with the biggest antennas you can't beat propagation - we did not hear a peep of KC1XX on 15m... S50A: more mults than on CW... S57W: surprise on Sunday at 2230 on 15 m: few US stn had come thru... SO5TW: few stateside signals heard at this QTH... SP1MHV: just before the end of the contest my son reset the computer and I lost all QTCs... SP6EQZ/9: despite high power my antennas seemed to be grounded... UA0WY: high noise level on all bands but good contest... UA9CIR: sunspots, where are you?... UT7EZ: fine business from 3V8BB... WZUP: not as much "last two letters" as last year. Heard VEs running EU simplex on 40m - it's not fair... WZ8A: electric power company just spent \$ 6 millions to advertise, but cannot maintain their lines: S9+ noise most of the contest... YB1AQ5: SF=67, A=16, K=3, terrible condx, but lots of fun with new 3 ele quad... YL2GN: worked 3V8BB on 3 bands... YO5BTZ: like this contest - good for dxing...
