Rules - Special Award DARC Team SES 2020

The DARC celebrates the 70th birthday of the DARC. At the same time it celebrates the foundation of the "Radiosportverband (RSV e.V.)" 30 years ago on March 24th 1990 as the first freely elected amateur radio association of the former German Democratic Republic. Inspired by the special event station activities the DARC-DX Committee is issuing a special award.



From July 1st through December 31st 2Ø2Ø, the applicant has to submit by both sides confirmed contacts with **DF7ØDARC**, **DP7ØDARC**, **DK7ØDARC** and **DM3ØRSV** using the <u>DCL</u> (DARC Community Logbook) as follows:

Work each special event station on two bands. You need 8 contacts. Please note the different times of activity of the special event stations.

The planned times for the activities of the special callsigns are published at www.70darc.club All amateur radio bands and modes within the privileges of the applicant's license may be used.

An award may be made specific to the following modes: CW, Fone, digital modes and mixed modes.

You can only apply for the award via the DARC Community Logbook (DCL). Therefore it is necessary to register and to load up your QSOs with the special activity stations into the DCL.

The award is available as a PDF download free of charge, or as paper version send by snail mail for a fee of 7 EUR.
