Special Award 30 years RSV - SWL-Version

The „Radiosportverband (RSV e.V.)“ was founded March 24th 1990 as the first freely elected amateur radio association of the former German Democratic Republic. The RSV existed until the merger with the DARC at the end of the same year. On this occasion, the Referat DX of the German Amateur Radio Club e.V. issues this special diploma.

From March 24th through October 2nd 2020, the applicant has to submit SWL-reports as follows:

Basic Award: two reports with each of the six DARC-Districts S, X, W, D, V and Y are required (the district is the first letter of the so called DOK). Another three reports of the special event station DM30RSV using three different amateur radios bands are required. A total of 15 reports are required.

Master Class: four reports with each of the six DARC-Districts S, X, W, D, V and Y are required (the district is the first letter of the so called DOK). Another three reports of the special event station DM30RSV using three different amateur radios bands are required. A total of 27 reports are required.

The planned times for the activities of the special callsigns are published at www.70darc.club

All amateur radio bands and modes may be used.

You can apply for the award by submitting a log-extract ordered by date. Both stations of the respective QSO shall be mentioned including date, time, band and mode.

The award is available as a PDF for a fee of 3 EUR, or as paper version for a fee of 7 EUR.

The cost of the award is payable via PayPal as instructed by the award manager.
